MEMORIAL GIVING PROGRAM

The Memorial Giving Program is for families who wish to have donations in memory of their loved ones directed to Grace Hospital. When memorial gifts are received by the Foundation, a tribute is created for the loved ones.

In Memoriam Tribute

Generally, families notify the community of the tribute in their loved ones obituary. The following wording is an example to use in an obituary:

“In lieu of flowers, charitable contributions can be made to the Grace Hospital Foundation.”

Once this has been done, we set up the tribute. As memorial donations come in, we regularly send the next of kin the names and addresses of those who have made contributions, as well as the ongoing tribute total. Donations can be made through our website, over the phone, in person, or by mail.

Memorial Recognition

When the cumulative total of the tribute is over \$2,500, we will contact the next of kin to discuss recognition opportunities. Loved ones can be recognized on the Memorial Stone in the Memory Garden by Sturgeon Creek. The Memory Garden is a place of tranquil reflection for Grace Hospice and Grace Hospital, as well as a place to memorialize loved ones in perpetuity.
